Common Courtesies

- No guys in girls' rooms and no girls in guys' rooms. (NO EXCEPTIONS) This applies to counselors as well.
- Keep your rooms neat and tidy; it is not the responsibility of counselor, Camp Director, or the Caretaker to clean your mess.
- Respect other people's property (no pranks!)
- No candles, scented plugins, incense, or scented sprays are allowed (Renuzit Air Fresheners are acceptable). Do not spray cologne, perfume, or hairspray in the room/cabin.
- RESPECT YOUR COUNSELOR!
- RESPECT ONE ANOTHER!
- As we will all be dining together (kids & youth), please be respectful to one another.
- Be respectful to the master chef and his/her staff.
- Say "please" and "thank you."
- When finished, properly dispose of the garbage in the garbage can and neatly stack your tray to be washed.
- Do not leave the dining area/porch area until the provided time is up.
- All participants (campers and adults) are required to attend all events and activities.
- 100% participation is expected and appreciated!
- No electronic devices in worship services or activities.
- Be present! Be engaged!
- Listen and Learn!
- It would be a good idea to bring a Bible & notepad.

- No guys in girls' showers/restrooms and no girls in guys' shower/restrooms.
- Do not leave any toiletries, or clothing, or towels in the shower/restroom.
- Bare foot is not recommended in the shower/restroom area.
- Showers at the pool area are reserved for adult volunteers, counselors, and Camp Team Staff.
- Keep the shower/restroom area clean! It will be less work for us later.
- NO ONE is to be in the pool or on the porch unless the lifeguard is present!
- For children, swim vests, floaties, or swimmies must be worn at all times.
- Sunscreen is always recommended!
- Keep up with your own towels and clothing.
- No running, or diving, or chicken fights.
- During pool time, THE LIFEGUARD IS BOSS! No exceptions!

In the event that a situation arises that is not covered by these rules, judgment shall be given at the discretion of the Camp Director/Camp Team.

Persistent "offenses" will result in a dismissal from Camp, upon which the parent/guardian will be expected to organize & pay for pick up.
